

DISTRUBUTION IN DISTRICT JHANG

The second distribution of food and non-food stuff was organized in Ahmad Pur Sayal District Jhang. Ahmad Pur Sayal is a historical and famous town by a cultural love story of Heer Ranjha. Ahmad Pur Sayal is the area from the Heer (girl) belongs to. Ahmad Pur Sayal is situated in the south side of the Jhang district. In Ahmad Pur Sayl at government special education school we distributed the flood relief goods in 80 flood affected families of the disabled people. Jhang district is badly affected by flood and monsoon's heavy rains. Wide area of the district including infrastructure has been damaged and the life is totally paralyzed in the flood affected areas of the district. Because of little far from the main city Ahmad Pur Sayal was neglected by the NGOs for relief work. Harmony Foundation visited and assessed the needs of the affected people specially the people with any kind of disability and worked on brick kiln.

MAJOR OCCUPATIONS

Major occupations of the people in the affected area are farmers and shepherd and work on the lands of the land lords and graze the animals but because of flood the corps are totally destroyed and land is not worthy for sowing of next season and animals are also flown in the flood that's why the economic condition of the people is very miserable. They are poor and they were already spending their lives from hand to mouth and the flood pushed them in more critical economic situation. Some of them are working on brick kilns factories.

HOW WE IDENTIFIED THE AREA AND OUR KEY PERSONS

Here again the local government officials helped us to find the disabled families and deserving families of the workers we find out by survey. Executive District Officer (Social Welfare) Sarfraz Ahmed and We contacted the principal of the special education school and he helped us to find the disabled people in the areas where the flood was hit. This time the students of the special education school were our beneficiaries. The principal gave us not only addresses but send a person with us who was known to the area.

METHODS OF DISTRIBUTION

To make the process of distribution transparent and to increase the access of deserving people to the relief goods we followed the following process

- We contacted the principal of special education school and collected the list of the disabled people
- We identified the families of workers and disabled people after visiting the wide area and in camps because their houses are destroyed and they are living in camps.
- We verified the families and then we issued a token and told them the date and place of the distribution

- On distribution day we reached on the spot and with the cooperation of the local government the people were there and we distributed the relief goods in the families of the workers and disabled people.

ITEMS DISTRIBUTED:

The food stuff was consisted of milk, sugar, cooking oil, rice, pulses, white grams, Tea, Dry milk, Salt, onion, turmeric, chilies, mix masala, Tea,

The non-food stuff consisted of utensils, mosquito nets, floor mattresses, hand towels, bath soap, dish bar, biscuits
